Import Data

Use this guide to:

• Import data from Microsoft Excel.

Note: The Restaurant Tips sample data is used here as an example (see Get Started > Import Data > Open Data).

JMP can open data from a variety of file types, including Microsoft Excel. This guide gives you an overview of how to get your Excel data into JMP.

Import Existing Data

To import data from Excel:

- 1. Go to File > Open.
- 2. Select your Excel file and click Open. The Excel Import Wizard opens.




Figure 1: Excel Import Wizard

- Select options in the wizard for how JMP should import your data, including where column headers start, how many rows of column headers are in the table, and where the data start.
- 4. Click Import. Your data is now in JMP format.

Customize Columns

You can customize your JMP data table, including modifying its columns.

To customize a column:

- 1. Right-click the column and select Column Info.
- Set column characteristics including format (how numbers should appear) and modeling type (what measurements in the column actually mean).




Figure 2: Column Properties

3. Save the data table in JMP using File > Save.
