Saving A Script

Use this guide to:

Understand how to automate analyses using a script saved to a data table.

After creating analyses, tables and graphs using JMP, you can easily recreate them using the JMP Scripting Language (JSL). This is useful if you need to recreate reports routinely.

You do not need to be a programmer to generate the JSL to recreate your reports—you can save the script in JMP for the next time you want to create a report.

Remember, for scripts in JMP:

- The red triangle menu for each report that you create includes an option to save the script that recreates the report.
- Use "Save script > To Data Table..." for easy access to related reports later.
- Scripts saved to a data table are displayed in the top left of the data table:




Figure 1: Scripts saved to Restaurant Tips data table in top left

- You can right-click a saved script to run or edit the script.
- Saved scripts contain the JSL required to recreate the reports you created previously. Only the script for the analysis is saved. If the data changes, the report you generate changes accordingly.
