

# Share Interactive Results

Use this guide to:

- Save JMP output as interactive HTML.
- Create interactive web reports.

*As an example, open the Restaurant Tips sample data table (Get Started > Share Interactive Results > Open Data).*

JMP makes it easy to share your output with others. Output from all JMP platforms is interactive.

## Save Output as Interactive HTML

You can share an interactive version of the results from a distribution, for example. To do this, go to File > Export > Interactive HTML with Data (Mac) or File > Publish (Windows). JMP creates an interactive HTML version of the distribution platforms that maintains the interactivity of all graphics in the distribution.

## Create Web Reports

You can also easily assemble many reports together at once, including distributions, graphs and dashboards into a web report. To combine these reports:

1. Open the reports to include in the web report.
2. Go to File > Publish.
3. Select the reports to be included in your web report and click Next.
4. Enter titles and descriptions for each report and click Build Report.

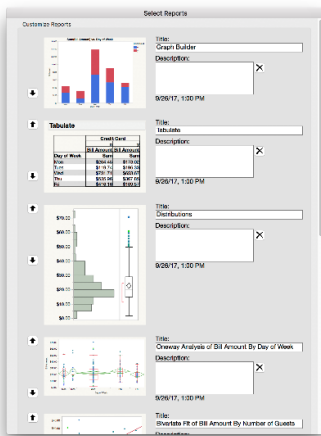


Figure 1: Add titles and descriptions for report

5. JMP assembles the reports into a single web package.

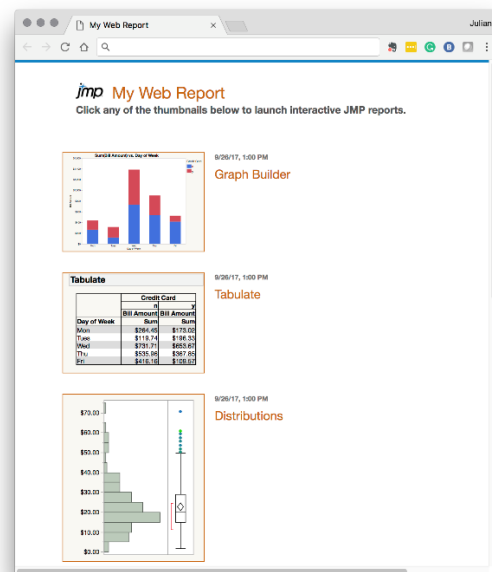


Figure 2: JMP Web Report

6. When you click on the icon next to a report, JMP displays the interactive version of the report.
7. The web report can be zipped and shared with colleagues, whether or not they have JMP.
